Later on in Berlin Sebastian gets more into printing projects at Neue Gestaltung and joins a small student design team in Weimar in order to design the annual exhibition at the Bauhaus University before extending his professional experience for six more months at Blottodesign.

Sebastian graduates from Bauhaus University in 2011 with a degree in visual communication. In his final work, which has been awarded a "Newcomer Award 2011" by the Art Directors Club Germany (ADC), he combines illustration, typography and photography.

Well prepared with a fine sense for aesthetics, a reflecting manner and an interest in digital as well as in analogue production techniques, he perfectly completes Claudia's design team. He shares her interest in improvisation and her motivation in pushing a project forward. Besides he contributes to the swiss publication "Happ-en - Ein Heft über die Tellerränder" with his illustrations and rediscovers the greater region.
